

### **RULES**

#### It is a condition of entry that Exhibitors agree to be bound by these rules

#### **CONDITIONS OF ADMITTANCE**

Persons are admitted to the Showground at their own risk and while every endeavour is taken to ensure their safety, CBEC Annual Open Show will not (save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of CBEC Annual Open Show, its servants or agents) be responsible for personal injury (whether fatal or otherwise) loss of or damage to property and any other loss, damage, costs and expenses however caused.

#### **SAFETY**

It is a condition of entry that exhibitors conform with the requirements of the Health and Safety Act 1974 and for ensuring that safe working practices are followed by themselves, their employees, agents and contractors. Exhibitors shall at all times comply with the instructions of the officials.

#### **INSURANCE**

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to insure all property and livestock on the Showground or elsewhere which is his own, or for which he/she is responsible.

#### HAT RULE

A strapped hat which is correctly fitted and complies with the current safety standards must be worn by <u>all exhibitors and judges</u> whilst mounted. All exhibitors under the age of 18 must wear must wear a strapped hat which is correctly fitted and complies with the current safety standards at all times ie In-Hand as well as mounted

CBEC strongly recommends that **all exhibitors** comply with the above hat recommendation however should exhibitors over the age of 18 wish to wear a strapless hat, they do so at their own risk and must sign the 'Hat Disclaimer' which is held in the Secretary's Tent. Any exhibitor found to be wearing a strapless hat who has not signed the declaration may be removed from the class.

- 1 The organisers accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, injury or damage to any person or their property whilst on the showground, car parks or approaches.
- 2 The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning a reason and will not tolerate bad behaviour of any kind.
- 3 Entry fees will not be refunded and it is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to ensure that their entry is correct, eligible and available when called for their class.
- 4 Exhibitors must take into consideration that classes may clash. If this occurs, they must nominate which class they wish to compete in.
- 5 No nomination or substitution entries will be accepted.
- 6 The Judges decision is final. Any objection must be made in writing with a deposit of £20.00 in cash, (to be forfeited if the objection is overruled), within 30 minutes of the class taking place.
- 7 Entries for affiliated classes will also be bound by the Rules and Conditions in force at the time of showing applicable to that Association and the class in which they are exhibiting. It is deemed by the organising Committee that exhibitors are conversant with any such rules, conditions or directives.
- 8 The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or split classes and alter or amend the running order of classes.
- 9 The organisers reserve the right to substitute other Judges for those announced in the Schedule or Catalogue for any who may be unavoidably prevented from attending. All entries are accepted on this understanding and no refund of entry fees can be made where a substitute is necessary. WHERE POSSIBLE, ANY AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULE WILL BE POSTED ON THE WEBSITE www.cbecannualopenshow.weebly.com
- 10 Exhibitors must enter the ring wearing the numbers allocated for that class.
- 11 Any horse/pony, which is not under complete control of a competent rider/handler or in any way constitutes a danger, will be asked to leave the Showground.
- 12 Stallions and colts must be adequately bitted.
- 13 Foals must be at least 3 weeks old on the day of the show.

- 14 The organisers reserve the right to expel any animal from the ring, which in their opinion is deemed not to be fit, or under sufficient control.
- 15 Anyone found mistreating a pony or horse may be asked to leave the Showground and reported to the appropriate body.
- 16 Show canes or whips to be no longer than 75 cms/30 inches.
- 17 Horses/ponies must enter and leave the ring at a walk.
- 18 All Exhibits must be shown in accordance with the Breed Society Rules pertaining.
- 19 Exhibitors must provide proof of registration on request.
- 20 Dogs must be kept on a lead and under control at all times whilst on the showground.
- 21 Please 'take your litter home'
- 22 Any exhibitor not complying with any of the rules of the Show can be disqualified.
- 23 Neat dress whilst in the judging rings is essential
- 24 Use of mobile phones in judging rings is prohibited
- 25 The organisers reserve the right to move classes between rings if the need arises. However, classes will not start before the time stated in the schedule. Any changes will be announced and current information will be available in the secretary's tent.

#### **RIDDEN HUNTER**

#### The judge will ride all exhibits unless otherwise stated

#### Judging 9.00am

#### Class

- 1 **NOVICE** mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 14.2hh.
- SMALL mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, exceeding 148cms (14.2hh approx) but not exceeding 158cms (15.2hh approx).
  This class is a qualifier for The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge and is also a qualifier for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at Equifest 2015.
- LIGHTWEIGHT mare or gelding, 4 years old or over, capable of carrying up to 79.5kgs (12stones 7lbs).
  This class is a qualifier for The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge and is also a qualifier for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at Equifest 2015.
- 4 **MIDDLEWEIGHT/HEAVYWEIGHT** mare or gelding, 4 years old or over. **Middleweights** capable of carrying over 79.5kgs (12stones 7lbs) up to 89kgs (14stones). **Heavyweights** capable of carrying over 89kgs (14stones). This class is a qualifier for The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge and is also a qualifier for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at Equifest 2015. The relevant Qualifiers will be awarded to the highest placed Middleweight and the highest placed Heavyweight.
- 5 **LADIES HUNTER** to be ridden by a lady side saddle, mare or gelding, 4 years old or over (please note: exhibits will not be ridden by the Judge). Competitors will be required to perform a short show

**CHAMPIONSHIP** - first and second prize winners from classes 1 - 5 to compete. Champion and Reserve are eligible to enter the Supreme Ridden Championship.

Ridden Hunter Classes 2 - 4 at this Show are qualifiers for THE BLUE CHIP & IDHS (GB) **£2000 CHALLENGE.** The highest placed horse (not already qualified) from each of these Classes that is registered or eligible for registration on the Irish Draught or Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers, ie with a minimum of 25% proven Irish Draught breeding, will qualify for the Final of the Blue Chip and IDHS (GB) £2000 Challenge. Horses need not be registered with the IDHS (GB) to qualify but must be on the IDHS (GB) Registers by the time of the Championship which will be held at the IDHS (GB) Breed Show in 2015 (date and venue to be confirmed). NB: A horse may only qualify for the Final once, regardless of the type or number of classes won, placed in or entered. Each qualifier will receive a card and a £10 voucher from Blue Chip. Qualifiers are required to complete an online form at www.idhsqb.com to inform the IDHS (GB) that they have qualified for the Final. Following submission of the online form, a qualifier's pack will be sent out direct to the qualifier. In the Final, the Champion will be awarded £1000 prize money, a Trophy and a Blue Chip rug. The Reserve Champion will be awarded £500 and 3rd to 7th inclusive will be awarded £100 each. In addition, the highest placed Pure Bred Irish Draught will be awarded £100 and a Trophy and the highest placed 158cm (15.2hh) and under will receive a Trophy and £50.

**The Irish Draught Horse Society (GB)** will award **Special Incentive Cards** to the highest placed Irish Draught Pure Bred or Irish Draught Sport Horse in Classes 1 - 5. To be eligible, exhibits must be registered with or overstamped by the IDHS (GB) on either their

*Irish Draught Breed Registers or Irish Draught Sport Horse Registers. Registration Numbers to be stated on the Entry Form.* 

#### THE BRITISH SHOW HORSE ASSOCIATION (BSHA)

Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Competitors and Horses must be registered or have temporary membership with a Day Ticket. Horses registered with the Association must be Owned, Exhibited and Ridden by current BSHA Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older.

#### DAY TICKETS

Non-Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Amateur, Home Produced, In-Hand, Novice, Working, Young Rider and Open Affiliated classes only, <u>but will NOT allow entry into</u> <u>RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes</u>. Horses registered on a Day Ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form from the BSHA website.

#### <u>Amateur</u>

Amateur Owner/Amateur Rider . Open to Horses owned and ridden by an Amateur, the Rider need not be the Owner of the Horse. Amateur Owner Rider/Home Produced . Open to Horses, which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January 2014 have not been shown by a Professional during the current season or stabled in a Professional yard at any time in 2014.

Horses competing in the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same show. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The three highest placed prize winners in all **Open** Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championship Show 2014.

- 7 LIGHTWEIGHT COB Mare or gelding, four years old and over, capable of carrying up to 14 stone, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. This class is a qualifier for The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge and is also a qualifier for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at Equifest 2015.
- 8 **HEAVYWEIGHT COB** Mare or gelding, four years old and over, capable of carrying more than 14 stone, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. **This class is a qualifier for The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge and is also a qualifier for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at Equifest 2015.**

- 9 **MAXI COB** Mare or gelding, four years old and over, exceeding 155cms. To be judged as Cobs. Judges must pay particular attention to type (i.e. short legged animals of COB type). To be shown hogged. This class is a qualifier for The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge and is also a qualifier for the relevant Equifest Championship class to be held at Equifest 2015.
- 9a AMATEUR COB/INCLUDING MAXI COB mare or gelding, 4 years old and over exceeding 148cms. This class is a qualifier for The Blue Chip & IDHS (GB) £2,000 Challenge
